

Dear NB Community:

As many of you know, the Governor has made those serving Ohio's students a priority with regards to vaccinations. We have been working collaboratively with our partners throughout Wood County on a plan to coordinate providing vaccines to our staff.

The Governor has indicated that counties will be notified this Friday when they can expect delivery of the doses needed to vaccinate all K-12 educators, public and private. They have not provided any insight as to which counties will be selected to receive their doses and when, but we do know that those who will be receiving their doses during the first week of February have been notified. We expect that they will roll out doses at the beginning of each week to counties during the month of February.

The public schools in Wood County intend to vaccinate all of their staff members on the same **Friday from 10:00am-3:00pm** in one of three locations. All of the Districts plan to have a remote or virtual instructional day to accommodate the nearly 3,000 people who want the vaccine. Perrysburg will host a site dedicated mainly to their staff, while Penta Career Center will be the location for staff members at Eastwood, Lake, Northwood, Penta Career Center and Rossford. **Bowling Green Middle School will be the third site where Bowling Green, Elmwood, North Baltimore, Otsego and the Wood County ESC staff members will receive their vaccines.**

We have chosen this plan to maximize the resources needed to complete the process. Doing so on a Friday allows employees the opportunity to recover if needed, over the weekend. There are still some details to work out, but our intention is to schedule our vaccination Friday in the week we receive the needed doses. I will keep in constant communication with you over the next several weeks.

On the day employees receive the vaccine all Wood County schools will have a **Virtual Learning Day**. This same process will be followed either three weeks or one month after the date of the first vaccine so Wood County school employees can receive their second vaccine. When that date has been determined it will be shared with you in a very timely manner.

I continue to thank you for your patience and flexibility.
